



## **Drug and Alcohol Driving Awareness Program (DADAP)**

**\*\*Class Open to Both Adults and Minors**

DADAP is designed to address the risks associated with alcohol and drug use/abuse and is intended to reduce the probability that persons completing the program will be involved in alcohol and driving situations. The curriculum is composed of six modules, including:

- Background of Alcohol/Drug Problems
- Physical/Psychological Effects of Alcohol/Drugs
- Texas Alcohol/Drug Laws
- Effects of Alcohol/Drugs on Driving
- Signs of Alcohol/Drug Abuse
- Decision Making

The course is a 6 hour class and is approved by the Texas Department of Education (TEA). All Texas drivers may take the course and are eligible for a 5% automobile insurance discount from participating agents. This could mean saving several hundred dollars on insurance premium costs in addition to reducing the chance of alcohol/drug related drug arrests or crashes.
